STANDING REPORTS

Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs Update: Dr. Ahn

Dr. Ahn gave a presentation highlighting the Women's Faculty Committee Awards Ceremony. She congratulated the seven award recipients, and presented two Award Ceremony slides that stated women are better represented at UMass Chan than the national average for medical schools, and that UMass Chan is outpacing our peer institutions in gender representation by academic rank.

Dr. Ahn announced that the Junior Faculty Development program's 2024 cohort graduation celebration took place on May 16th and applications for the 2025 cohort are currently being accepted.

Dr. Ahn announced that the Women's Faculty Committee is having a Virtual Health Event on *Women and Stroke: Differences in Clinical Presentation, Severity & Outcomes* on Friday, June 21st from 12:00-1:15.
