Perioperative & Maternal Care is an integrated thematic section incorporating the Surgery and OB/GYN Clerkships offered at UMASS campus, Memorial Campus, St. Vincent's, Milford Regional Medical Center, Baystate Medical Center, Berkshire Medical Center and Cape Cod Hospital.

After the completion of the Perioperative & Maternal Care thematic section, the MS3 student will be able to:

1. Recognize the integrated thematic sections of OB/GYN and Surgery in Perioperative and Maternal Care (Physician as Professional and Clinical Problem Solver)
2. Share content on Surgical Care, Analgesia and Anesthesia, Pain Management, Fluid and Electrolytes and Pre-operative evaluation and participate in surgical, round robin skills sessions for Perioperative and Maternal Care (Physician as Communicator, Clinical Problem Solver, and Scientist)
3. Review content on Abortion Ethics and complete reflection and organ transplant ethical exercises (Physician as a Person, Professional, Communicator, and Clinical Problem Solver)
